Minutes form July 3, 2007 meting

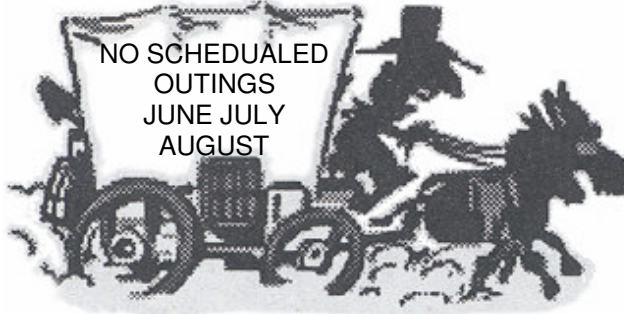
