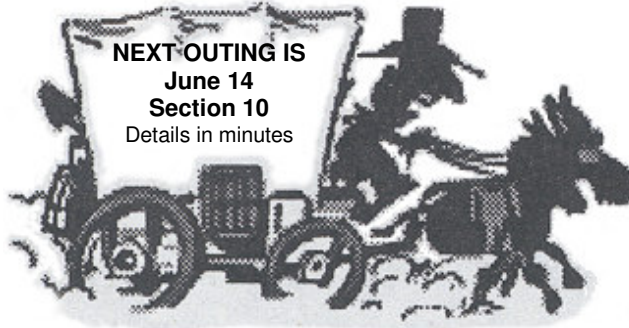
Pledge of allegiance followed.

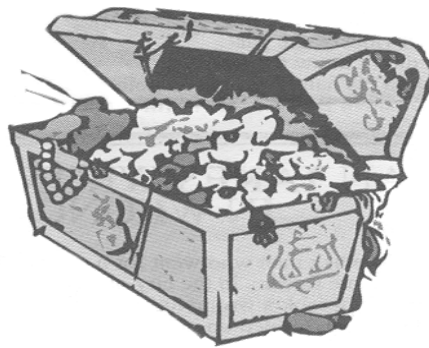
