May 6, 2008

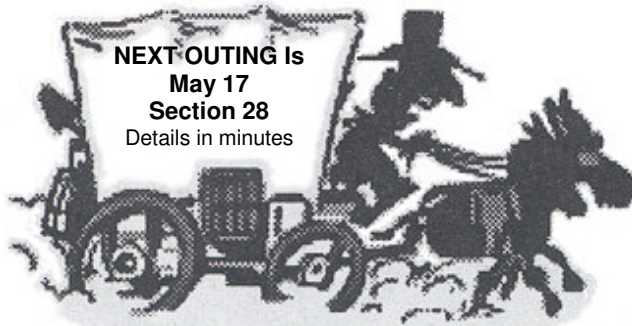

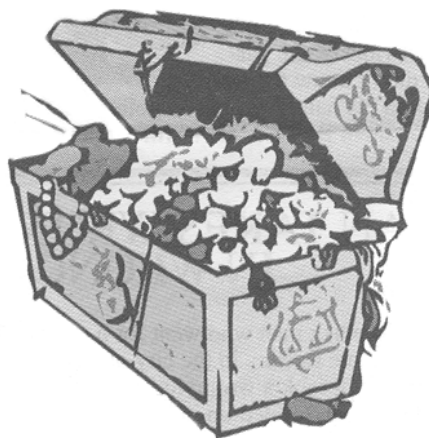
