Reminder that next month we will be holding the losing ticket raffle, bring those blue tickets with you.

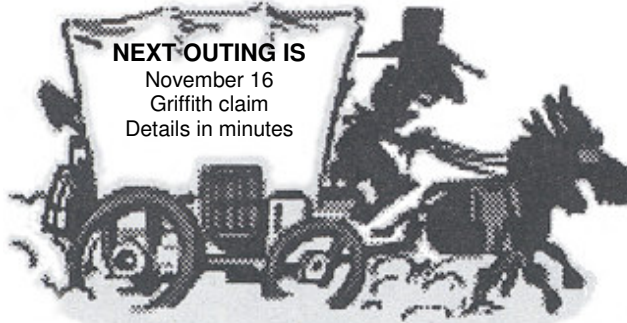
