bers.

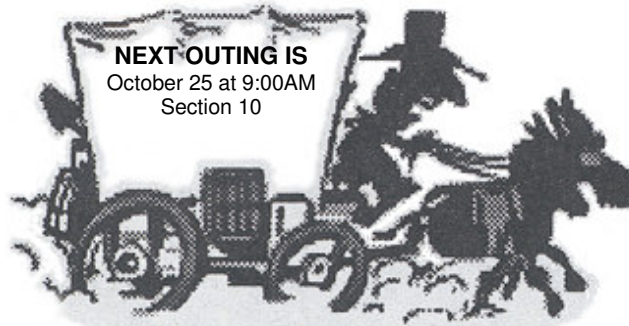
The issue has been tabled to next
