utes as read – Seconded.

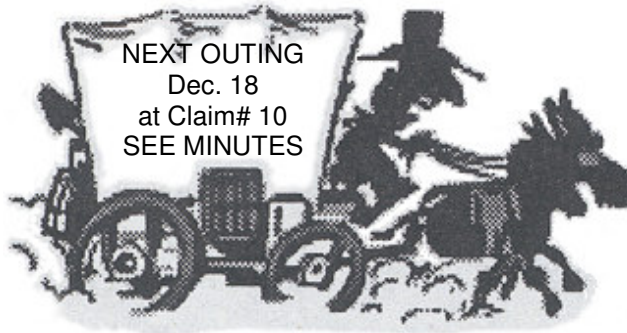
New Business
