Old Business:

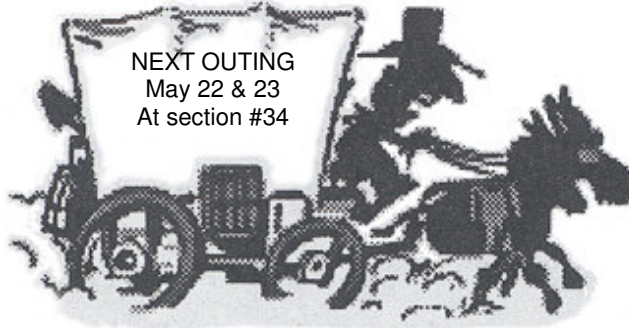
